Shower-proof

Your wound has been dressed with a dressing with Safetac[®], an adhesive designed to minimise pain on removal.

Caution: If you see changes in the wound and/or surrounding skin, such as redness, pain, heat, swelling or odour, please contact your healthcare professional.

When should your dressing be changed?

- This dressing can be left intact for up to seven days depending on the wound condition and the surrounding skin¹.
- Dressing should be changed if surgical exudate leaks from the dressing or out into the borders; when the absorbent pad is fully saturated (3 out of 4 corners); and at any sign of infection.
- Please contact your healthcare professional if you feel your dressing needs changing.
